Leighton Ford

Dr. Ford is president of Leighton Ford Ministries which focuses on raising up younger leaders to spread the message of Christ worldwide. After thirty years of involvement in evangelism - preaching in 37 countries and on every continent - he

has spent the last twenty-five years of his life as a mentor and spiritual director for younger men and women. His current mission: to be "an artist of the soul and friend on the journey."

Leighton Ford is the author of 11 books, including the award-winning *Sandy: A Heart for God* (the biography of his son who died during heart surgery in 1981) and *Transforming Leadership*. His most recent book is *The Attentive Life*, published by InterVarsity Press. An ordained Presbyterian minister, he was named Clergyman of the Year in 1985 by Religious Heritage of America, and as Presbyterian Preacher of the Year by the National Presbyterian Center. Dr. Ford was vice-president of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, where he served for 31 years. He was also a regular alternate speaker with Billy Graham, his brother-in-law, on the Hour of Decision and produced his own radio and television spots in the United States, Canada and Australia.

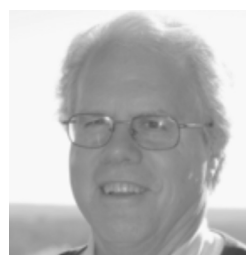
